There is an overweight permit issued by the WI DOT under 348.27 that allows for loads up to 100,000 pounds. The transporter would be required to apply for and receive this permit. This permit is not valid during the spring thaw, and all loads during this time period would have to be reduced to at or around 6,000 gallons in order to be at the maximum legal load size of 80,000 pounds. This overweight permit is also not valid in Minnesota. All loads going to and from Minnesota communities would have to be within the 80,000 pound rule,

Schedule A-1 (PER GALLON) Rate instructions,

The members pay a set price per gallon no matter which member community it comes from.

The current price is \$0.03567 per gallon.

8000 gallons times \$0.03567 per gallon equals \$285.36 per load.

6000 gallons times \$0.03567 per gallon equals \$214.02 per load.

Non-Member Load charge calculations for non-members:

Using Cadott for example: (Cadott is no longer a user)

\$0.000777 is the rate per mile-gallon contract base price for 2021

78 miles (one way) times \$0.000777 per mile per gallon equals \$0.06061 per gallon.

Assume completely full loads and no fuel adjustment

8000 gallons times \$0.06061 per gallon equals \$484.85 for one load from Cadott

6000 gallons times \$0.06061 per gallon equals \$363.64 for one load from Cadott

Each load is weighted so the bill is based on actual gallons per load not estimates.

**WEST CENTRAL WISCONSIN BIOSOLIDS FACILITY  
BIOSOLIDS CENTRATE TRANSPORTATION CONTRACT  
July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022 - June 30<sup>th</sup> 2027**

This agreement dated as of the \_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_ in the year 2021 by and between the WEST CENTRAL WISCONSIN BIOSOLIDS COMMISSION herein called “Commission” and

\_\_\_\_\_, herein called “transporter and West Central Wisconsin Biosolids Facility herein called “Biosolids Facility”.

Commission and transporter, in consideration of the mutual covenants herein after set forth, agree as follows:

1. WORK The transporter does hereby provide covenants, promises and agrees to and with the Commission that it will adequately and sufficiently furnish all labor and equipment necessary to transport the biosolids from the Member Facility to the Biosolids Facility and transport the centrate back to the Member Facilities in a complete and workmanlike manner in accordance with all local, state, federal laws and regulations.
  - a. The transporter shall provide a vacuum/pressure type 8,000-gallon capacity tank to load and unload the biosolids and centrate. The connection for the transporter shall be a 6” quick connect coupling to all member facilities. The transporter shall keep all loading and unloading areas clean and orderly.
  - b. The work shall consist of: Loading of centrate at the Biosolids facility. Transporting the centrate to a Member, Non – Member or contracted facility. Unloading of centrate at that facility. Loading of biosolids from the Member, Non-Member, or contracted facility. Transport biosolids to the Biosolids Facility and then unload at the Biosolids Facility.
  - c. The Biosolids Superintendent shall review all schedules, which may include evening or early morning delivery. The transporter shall respond to a call from the Biosolids Facility within 24 hours. The Biosolids Facility shall be responsible for calculating and reporting volumes to the transporter.
  - d. The transporter shall provide a tank for transporting the biosolids that is at least as clean as the biosolids to be transported. Substance not found in the biosolids, such as petroleum products or other chemicals shall be cleaned from the tank before loading biosolids and centrate.
2. TERM This contract shall be in effect for a period of 5 years.

Upon the Commission acceptance of the biosolids transportation bid the transporter shall post a performance bond of \$100,000 each year payable to the West Central Wisconsin Biosolids Commission for breach of this contract by the transporter.

The initial term of this contract shall begin on July 1<sup>st</sup> 2022 and shall continue to June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2027. A contract extension may be negotiated if, at the sole discretion of the Commission, the work performed by the transporter has been satisfactory.

3. PAYMENT In consideration for the services provided by the transporter to the Biosolids Facility, the Commission agrees to pay the transporter based on “ Schedule 1” (insert rate schedule here) of the bid documents.

4. TERMINATION In the event of unsatisfactory work on the part of the transporter as judged by the Commission, the Commission shall give written notice to the transporter identifying the deficiencies. Unsatisfactory work may include, but is not limited to, failure to transport biosolids and centrate within 24 hours of notification, or delivery of biosolids and centrate to an unapproved destination. If, in the judgment of the Commission and upon written notification from the Commission to the transporter, it is the responsibility of the transporter to make corrections in the unsatisfactory work or action plan to be taken within 48 hours or a reasonable time the Commission deems appropriate. If this has not been done by the transporter within 48 hours the Commission may declare this agreement null and void and collected on the posted bond. Act of God including reason for force of nature, acts of public enemy, wars, blockades, insurrections, riots, strikes, epidemics, lightning, earthquake, tornadoes, fires, storms, floods, washouts, civil disturbances, and explosions shall not be grounds for contract termination.

5. TRANSPORTERS REPRESENTATION The transporter warrants he has possession of sufficient equipment and personnel to successfully perform the work required under this contract.

6. Shop / Garage Use, Transporter will be allowed to perform light maintenance duties and store incidental supplies at the Facility. The garage area shall always be kept clean.

7. ASSIGNMENT OF CONTRACT The transporter shall not assign this contract or any parts hereof, nor sublet this contract nor any part thereof without the prior written consent of the Commission.

8. INSURANCE/OTHER REQUIREMENTS The transporter shall purchase and maintain such comprehensive and general liability insurance as to provide protection from claim set forth below which may arise out of or result from transporters performance work.

Transporter shall follow the Federal and State drug and alcohol-testing program for each driver.

The transporter shall have on file at the Biosolids Facility an “Emergency Spill Plan” which shall include but not be limited to plan of action, notification list (shall include phone numbers, contact person of State and local governments) and procedures for cleanup. Plan shall be approved by the Biosolids Superintendent prior to transporting the first load. Cleanup of a spill would be the responsibility of the transporter.

10. CONTRACT BINDING UPON SUCCESSION All of the provisions and agreements of this contract shall inure to the benefit of and binding upon the heirs, executors, administrators, representatives, successors, and assigns of the respective parties hereto as fully as upon the said parties.

**Item No. 1 Extra Centrate**

Centrate is returned to the wastewater plants with each load. From time to time there is a need to have extra centrate hauled from the WCWBF to wastewater facilities. This is mainly due to water used for cleaning. This must be hauled out with no biosolids hauled back. Most of the extra centrate is hauled to the River Falls wastewater plant. Ellsworth and Baldwin are set up to take extra centrate, if needed. What would the charge be to haul extra centrate from the WCWBF to the facility below.

**Item No. 2 Fuel cost adjustment for Schedule 1 option A rate per gallon**

If the charge for service is per gallon hauled, there is a fuel clause in the current contract, which over time has been changed. Contract fuel price is currently set at 3.009 per gallon. The current fuel price is an average of the actual fuel price per gallon each month.

Cfp = current fuel price

Sfp = Starting fuel price

Cp = Contract price

$\frac{Cfp - Sfp}{Sfp}$  times Cp divided by 2 equals fuel clause

Sfp

Written out as current fuel price minus starting fuel price divided by starting fuel price times contract price divided by two equals the fuel clause adjustment. The contract price is the price listed in the signed contract.. The fuel clause will be adjusted every month It can go up or down.
