

## **17.84.050 Political campaign signs.**

Political campaign signs shall adhere to the regulations contained herein. It shall be the responsibility of the candidate or his or her designee to insure that political campaign signs are installed in compliance with these regulations. The following regulations shall apply to all zoning districts within the city:

A. No permit shall be required for the installation of a political campaign sign within the city.

B. The city assumes the authority to enforce the applicable provisions of these sign regulations even though no permit is required.

C. All political campaign signs shall be erected on private property and at least a distance of fifteen (15) feet from the edge of pavement.

D. All political campaign signs shall be removed within seventy-two (72) hours following the election in which the campaign was intended.

E. No political campaign sign shall be installed within the city more than seventy (70) days prior to the election in which the campaign is directed.

F. No political campaign sign shall be attached to any boulevard tree, utility pole or traffic control device.

G. All political signs in residential zoning districts shall not be lighted. (Ord. 2001-14 (part): prior code § 21.49)
