

## Common Area Lighting Program (CALP)

The CALP program is specifically geared toward lighting fixtures operating more than 12 hours per day in buildings with four or more units. For a low \$179 co-pay, your building may receive any combination of the following, up to \$2,500 in product:

- 2 Lamp, 4' Reduced Wattage Lamp (28W)
- Interior CLF Fixtures
- Exterior CLF Fixtures
- Occupancy Sensors
- LED Exit Signs

## Express Energy Efficiency Program

Receive the following FREE energy-saving products (\$100 value):

- Residence can be owner or renter occupied. Renters must obtain permission from their landlord.
