





# Common Area Lighting Package

- The CALP program is specifically geared toward lighting fixtures operating more than 12 hours per day in buildings with four or more units. For a **low \$179 co-pay**, your building may receive any combination of the following, up to **\$2,500 in product**:
  - 2 Lamp, 4' Reduced Wattage Lamp (28W)
  - Interior CLF Fixtures
  - Exterior CLF Fixtures
  - Occupancy Sensors
  - LED Exit Signs
